EMS Bicycle Operations

Calling all EMT's and Paramedics!



Students are tested on concepts learned in the course through both written and on-bike testing. Eligibility for certification as an IPMBA-EMS Cyclist is available to students successfully completing the practical tests and receiving a score of 76% or better on the written test.

Applicants must currently be EMS personnel on bike, applying to become a member of a unit, or members of a unit considering the use of the bicycle.

Central Florida Fire Academy offers you the **EMS Bicycle Operations Course**. This 32-hour course was designed by the IPMBA Education Committee, in cooperation with EMT's and Paramedics on bikes from across the country. It equips the EMT or Paramedic for the rapidly expanding area of bicycle operations.

Students learn:

- basic and emergency bike handling skills;
- riding single and in pairs in diverse traffic situations;
- ways to effectively and safely pack equipment;
- techniques designed to safely handle EMS scenes
- personal safety techniques

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Travel Directions

- **From the Florida Turnpike**, take Exit 259 and head **east** on I-4.
- **From I-4** take Exit 79 and head **south** on John Young Pkwy to Oak Ridge Road.
- **From the East-West Expressway** (408/toll) take Exit 8. Head **south** on John Young Pkwy.
- **From the Beeline Expressway** (528/toll) take Exit 3 and head **north** on John Young Pkwy.
- **If traveling south on John Young Pkwy**, turn **left** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)
- **If traveling north on John Young Pkwy**, turn **right** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)

Parking Directions

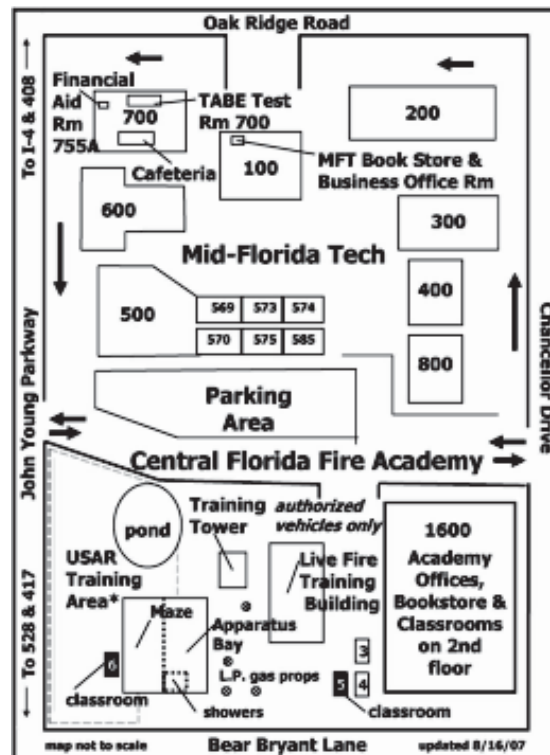
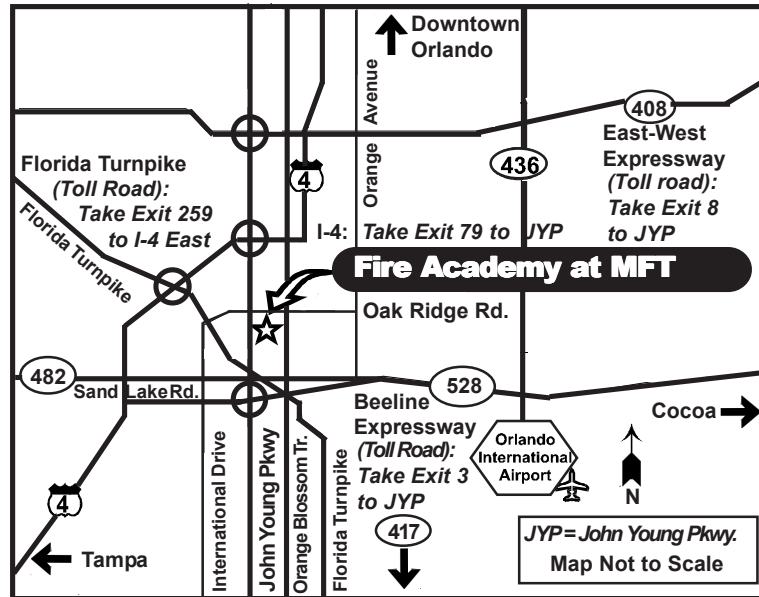
