Become a Certified Driver/Operator

The 80-hour **Driver Operator Course** combines the curriculums of the BFST's *Fire Service Hydraulics* and *Apparatus Operations*. It prepares certified firefighters to drive and operate today's pumpers, and to take the State Engineer's Certification Test.

Students learn and perform tasks in pump operations, field hydraulics, apparatus familiarization, driving and preventative maintenance – **all in accordance with NFPA 1002 Standards.**

Five days of classroom work are followed with **five days of hands-on practice, which are scheduled on a shift-friendly basis.** Each practical and the final exam are offered twice a week. As far as possible, students may choose which of the two days to attend.

Lecture topics include water distribution systems, maintenance, hydrants, friction loss, types of pumps, and priming devices.

Practicals include training in safe driving practices, drafting, and pumping evolutions. Students drive the "Serpentine Course" and take part in exercises involving pumping-relay, sprinkler systems, tandem pumping, and master stream devices.

You must buy the required book and **read Chapters 1-6 and chapter 8 before** the first day of class. (Pump Apparatus Driver/Operator Handbook, 2nd edition, available at the Academy reception desk on the second floor of the 1600 building.)
