Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

Help save lives. Become an EMT!



You will learn to...

- give first aid treatment
- respond to instructions from emergency medical dispatchers
- drive specially equipped emergency vehicle to scene of accident or catastrophe
- determine nature and extent of illness/injury
- give medical care such as opening and maintaining an airway, restoring breathing, controlling bleeding, treating for shock, putting splints on fractures, bandaging, assisting in childbirth, managing mentally disturbed patients, and giving initial care to poison and burn victims.
- look for medical I.D.
- place patients on stretchers and lift them into ambulance
- give oxygen or artificial resuscitation, when needed
- report by radio directly to hospital emergency department about nature and extent of injuries/illness
- help transport victim and transfer to hospital

Central Florida Fire Academy is now offering a *basic **Emergency Medical Technician** course* for people interested in becoming an EMT only, as well as for those who wish to continue on afterwards for firefighter training.

This 266 hour course is designed to prepare you for employment as an EMT. Instruction includes training in emergency skills, practice mock situations, emergency room and emergency rescue and transport. This course prepares you for the National and/or State exam.

The course includes 90 hours of Health Core and 80 hours of Practical Training. The Practical Training includes 24 hours of hospital and 56 hours of rescue.

Travel Directions

- **From the Florida Turnpike**, take Exit 259 and head **east** on I-4.
- **From I-4** take Exit 79 and head **south** on John Young Pkwy to Oak Ridge Road.
- **From the East-West Expressway** (408/toll) take Exit 8. Head **south** on John Young Pkwy.
- **From the Beeline Expressway** (528/toll) take Exit 3 and head **north** on John Young Pkwy.
- **If traveling south on John Young Pkwy**, turn **left** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)
- **If traveling north on John Young Pkwy**, turn **right** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)

Parking Directions

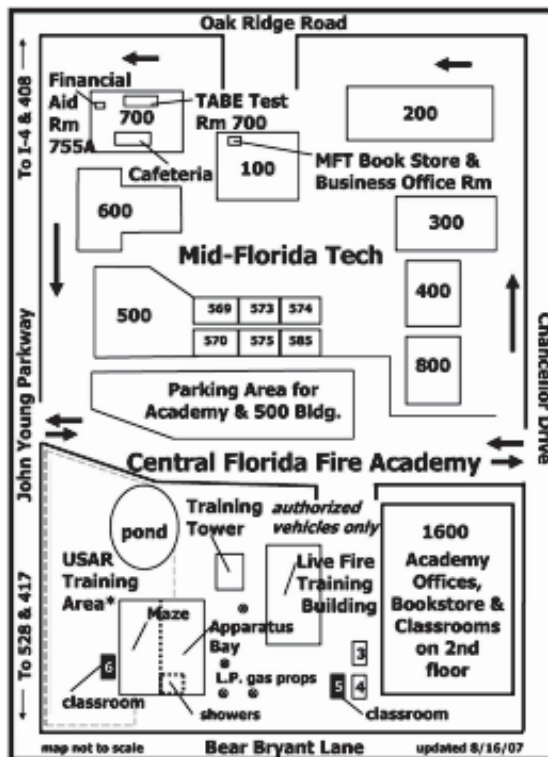
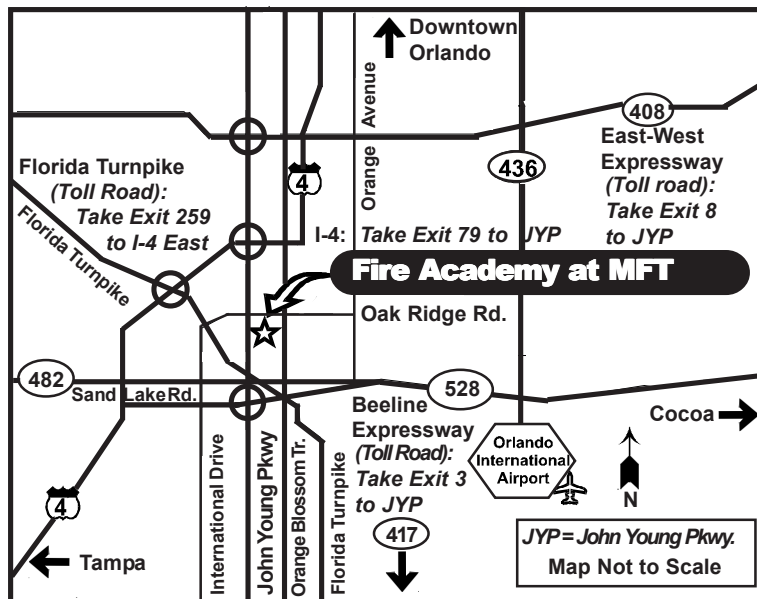
