Truck Company Operations does not focus on the appropriate use of a tower truck apparatus. Instead, it provides education and hands on training in the *functions* normally performed by a truck company crew. Topics covered are:

- ventilation practices
- forcible entry functions
- search tactics
- building construction
- ground ladder placement
