Learn safe driving and get your EVOC certificate

To help emergency vehicle drivers cope with the increased possibility of accidents and provide them with useful additional training, the Central Florida Fire Academy offers a 16-hour Emergency Vehicle Operators Course. This comprehensive course meets all EVOC certification standards required by the State of Florida.

Every day, drivers of virtually every type of emergency vehicle need to operate beyond the limits normally experienced by the private driver. The very nature of emergency driving places extreme demands on both the driver and the vehicle.

This program teaches drivers to avoid the types of accidents most often experienced in the line of duty. The concept of safe driving is taught both in the classroom and on the driving range.

The course is designed to:

- Educate drivers about the legal aspects of Emergency Vehicle Operation
- Train drivers in the techniques of accident avoidance
- Upgrade driver skills required for safe and efficient operation

This course is a must for EMT students/graduates; firefighter students/graduates; Fire Department engineers and district commanders.



Class Information

The first day centers on classroom lecture and discussion. On the second day, students practice their new skills, using their own vehicles and the Academy's rescue truck.

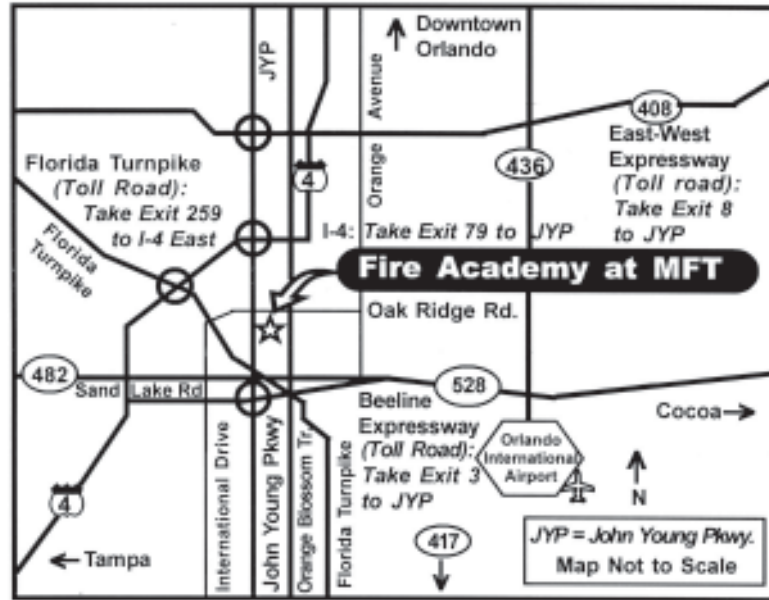

Travel Directions

- From the Florida Turnpike, take Exit 259 and head **east** on I-4.
- From I-4 take Exit 79 and head **south** on John Young Pkwy to Oak Ridge Road.
- From the East-West Expressway (408/toll) take Exit 8. Head **south** on John Young Pkwy.
- From the Beeline Expressway (528/toll) take Exit 3 and head **north** on John Young Pkwy.
- If traveling **south** on John Young Pkwy, turn **left** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)
- If traveling **north** on John Young Pkwy, turn **right** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)



Parking Directions

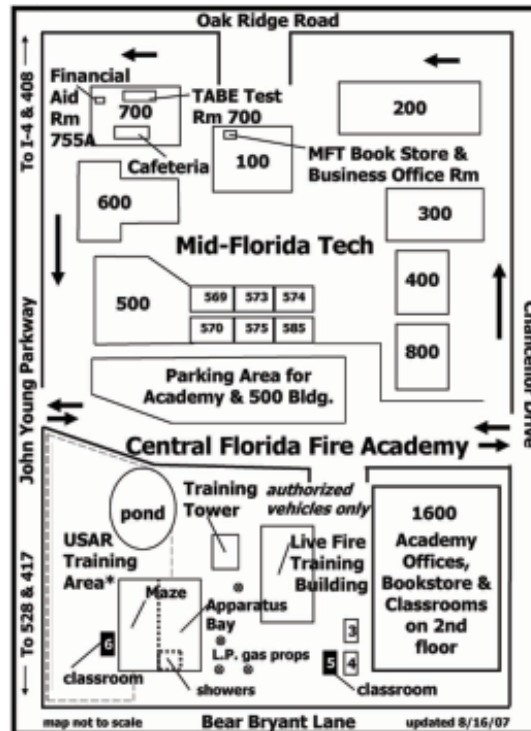
