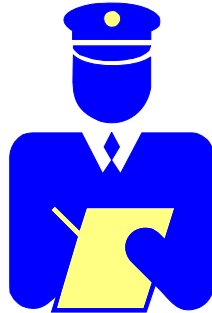

Fire Inspector In-service (Recert) Training

Update and Share Your Knowledge in a 6-hour Re-certification Class



The Central Florida Fire Academy offers monthly classes to help you update your knowledge in Fire Inspection. Instruction is given on the most recent updates, newest topics and latest equipment.

Former graduates of this class agree that the biggest benefit is the opportunity to learn, discuss and share with other Fire Inspectors. Their experiences and examples of real life problem solving have proven to be invaluable in the field.

Each session features a different expert and subject matter. Topics and experts are recommended by current Fire Inspectors and Fire Marshals.

Each training session is registered for Fire Inspector Recertification with the BFST in Ocala. A certificate will be issued at the end of the day for the amount of time you have attended class.

This course also qualifies for Special Inspector Recertification (required every three years), and for Department of Education and HRS Certifications.

Classes meet from **0830-1530** on the **fourth Thursday** of each month. **Exception due to holiday:** November's class is usually held on the Thursday before Thanksgiving.

- From the Florida Turnpike, take Exit 259 and head **east** on I-4.
- From I-4 take Exit 79 and head **south** on John Young Pkwy to Oak Ridge Road.
- From the East-West Expressway (408/toll) take Exit 8. Head **south** on John Young Pkwy.
- From the Beeline Expressway (528/toll) take Exit 3 and head **north** on John Young Pkwy.
- If traveling **south** on John Young Pkwy, turn **left** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancelor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)

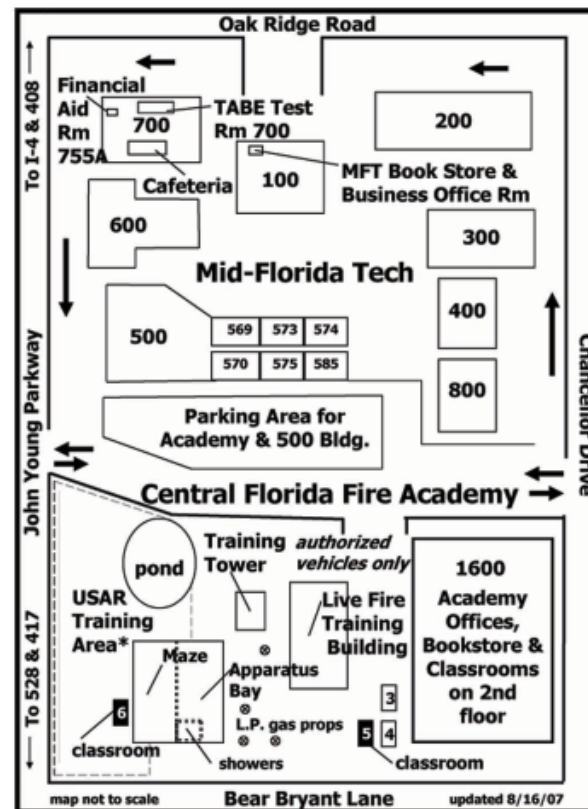

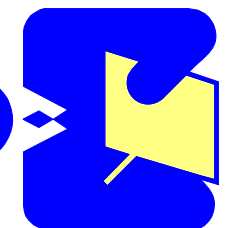
