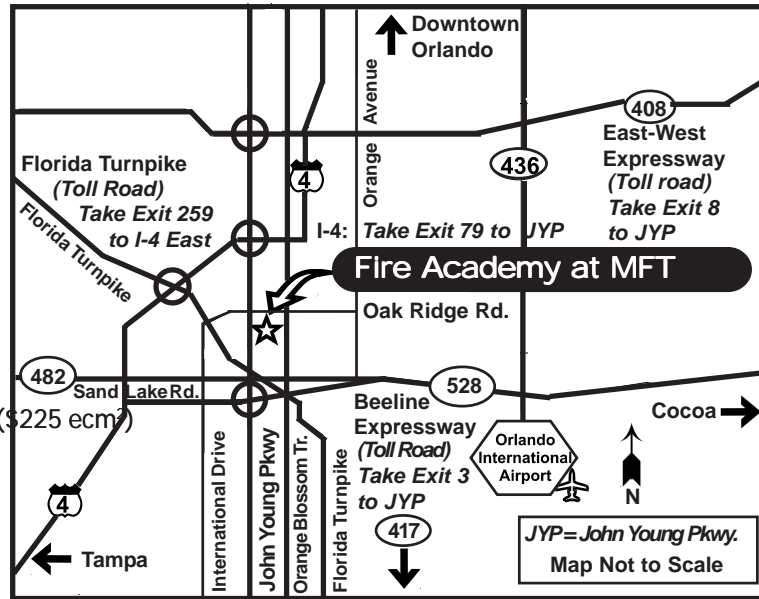

# Fire Inspector II

## Travel Directions

- From the Florida Turnpike, take Exit 259 and head **east** on I-4.
- From I-4 take Exit 79 and head **south** on John Young Pkwy to Oak Ridge Rd.
- From the East-West Expressway (408/toll) take Exit 8. Head **south** on John Young Pkwy.
- From the Beeline Expressway (528/toll) take Exit 3 and head **north** on John Young Pkwy.
- If traveling **south** on John Young Pkwy, turn **left** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)
- If traveling **north** on John Young Pkwy, turn **right** at Oak Ridge Rd. Make a **right** turn at Chancellor Dr. and proceed to the last MFT entrance. (See map below.)



## Parking Directions

Central Florida Fire Academy is on the campus of Mid Florida Tech. The office and classrooms are on the 2nd floor of Building 1600, on the south end of the campus next to the Fire Training Area.

Park in the area between the Fire Training Grounds and the 500 Building. A few spaces in front of the 1600 building are reserved for **visits of two hours or less**.

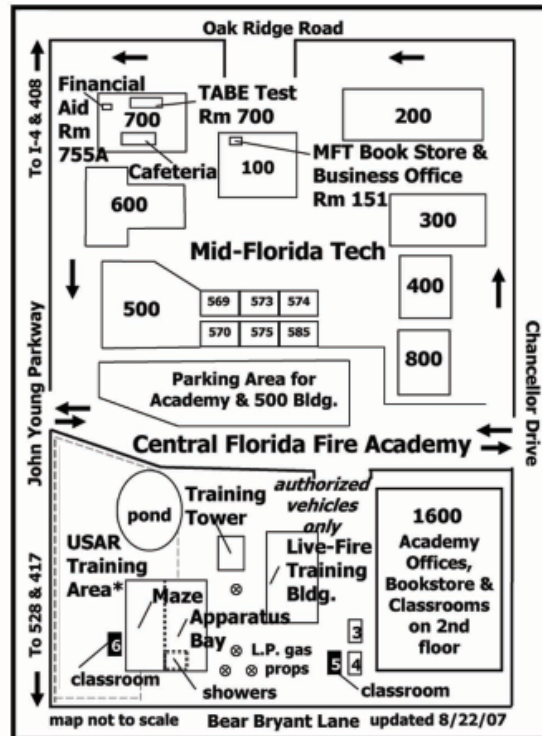

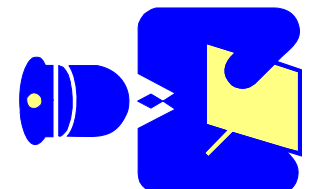

## Fire Inspector II

### Only Four More Courses for Inspector II

If you have State of Florida certification as Fire Inspector I, you need only four more courses to qualify for Fire Inspector II. Each course meets one day a week for five weeks.

#### **FFP2541: Private Fire Protection Systems II**

Sprinkler and standpipe systems, chemical extinguishing systems, and detection systems and devices. Each system is discussed as to its need, construction, preventative maintenance and individual uses.
