## INSTRUCTORS: GET STATE CERTIFICATION AS A LIVE FIRE INSTRUCTOR

The Academy will be offering a 40-hour Live Fire Instructor course the week of February 8-12, 2010. Class time will be from 0900-1800. Cost is \$250 for the general public and \$200 for employees of agencies that are members of the Central Florida Fire Academy Consortium. To take this course, you must already be Florida certified as Instructor I or higher.



This course is designed to deliver a comprehensive live-fire training program in accordance with NFPA 1402, NFPA 1403, and NFPA 1500. Both lecture and practical will be used, allowing participants to apply knowledge of the above standards to live fire training activities. After successful completion of the course you will be eligible for the State exam. Once you pass that, you will be allowed to conduct live fire training in the State of Florida. Bunker gear and airpacks are required.
